



Privacy Policy

Somerset FA ("We") take your privacy very seriously. Please read this Policy carefully to see how we will treat the personal information that you provide us with when using our website. We will take all reasonable care to keep your personal information secure and to prevent any unauthorised access or unlawful use of it. We process all information in accordance with the UK Data Protection Legislation. We may change this Privacy Policy from time to time and the change will take effect once the revision is entered on our homepage. Please refer to this policy if you feel the need when submitting your personal information.

Collection of personal information

We may ask you to provide *information at* certain points on our premises, which include, but are not limited to, your name, postal address, date of birth, gender, telephone numbers, email address, and where appropriate your National Participant Database Number and Referee Registration Number.

The information that you are asked to provide will vary depending on the reason for it. In some instances, the provision of certain information will be mandatory.

How we will use your information

We will use your personal information for such purposes as:

- i. verifying your identity, where required;
- ii. managing and administering county football;
- iii. managing and administering disciplinary actions;
- iv. responding to enquiries;
- v. sending information to you;
- vi. sending marketing information to you in accordance with the provisions set out below.

We, like other Affiliated Associations and selected third parties (such as our commercial partners), may like to send you marketing information by e-mail, or SMS. We will only do this if you have indicated that you are happy to receive such information when you submit your details to us.

We may also send you marketing information by post. If you do not wish to receive this marketing information, or if you wish to opt out of future email or SMS marketing, please write to the Chief Executive at the address below.

We may wish to disclose information about you to third parties. We will not do so without in the first place obtaining written confirmation from you seeking your authority.

We may aggregate the information you send to us with other data (so that you cannot be identified from that data) and use that aggregated data for administrative purposes and/or share it with other people. In particular we may provide such aggregated data to The FA for statistical analysis where such analysis will identify the demand for football in certain areas, trends for participation in the game and allow The FA to direct its resources to those areas of the game which are in most need such as facilities and football development.
